1) The Applicant must be either a Veteran as Defined in N.D.C.C. § 37-14-01.1 or an unremarried widow/widower of an eligible Veteran. **►** 

37-14-01.1. Definition of veteran.

- 1. As used in this chapter, "veteran" means:
- a. An individual who served in the armed forces of the United States on federal active duty:
  - (1) For reasons other than training and who has been discharged under other than dishonorable conditions; or
  - (2) To whom the United States veterans administration has assigned a service-connected disability rating;
  - b. Current members of the national guard or reserve; or
- c. Former members of the national guard or reserve who have been discharged under other than dishonorable conditions.
- 2) The applicant must have the financial ability to repay the loan.
- 3) The applicant must be a resident of North Dakota for one (1) year prior to date of application. ▶
  - Applicants that have been incarcerated in a Correctional or Correctional Treatment Facility.
    - 1) Applicants must provide proof of one (1) year North Dakota residency prior to entering a correctional or correctional treatment facility.
    - 2) Time spent incarcerated does not count toward the one (1) year residency time requirement.
    - 3) Applicants currently incarcerated in a correctional or correctional treatment facility are not eligible to apply.
- 4) If application is found to include fraudulent information, the application shall not be considered.
- 5) Applicants may be eligible for both the hardship assistance program and the loan program.
- 6) Applicants who have outstanding delinquent Veterans Aid Loans are eligible for the Grant Program.
