1) The Applicant must be either a Veteran as Defined in N.D.C.C. § 37-14-01.1, a spouse of an eligible Veteran or an un-remarried widow/widower of an eligible Veteran.

37-14-01.1. Definition of veteran.

As used in this chapter, "veteran" means an individual who served in the armed forces of the United States on federal active duty:

- 1. For reasons other than training and who has been discharged under other than dishonorable conditions; or
- 2. To whom the United States veterans administration has assigned a service-connected disability rating.
- 2) The applicant must be residing in North Dakota with the intent of establishing permanent residency.
 - a. Applicants that have been incarcerated in a Correctional or Correctional Treatment Facility.
 - 1. Must provide proof of North Dakota residency prior to entering a correctional or correctional treatment facility.
 - 2. Time spent incarcerated does not count toward the residency time requirement.
 - 3. Applicants currently incarcerated in a correctional or correctional treatment facility are not eligible to apply.
- 3) If application is found to include fraudulent information, the application shall not be considered.
- 4) Applicants who have outstanding delinquent Veterans Aid Loans are eligible for the Grant Program.
