Awarded the French Legion d'Honneur (chevalier), by Presidential Decree of May 10, 1919, and the French Croix de Guerre with palm, under Order No. 16,527 "D", dated April 19, 1919, General Headquarters, French Armies of the East, with the following citation: "Heedless of danger he captured with his platoon two machine guns which were retarding the progress of his battalion. Although severely wounded, he fulfilled his mission completely in attaining his objective."
